4. How involved are you in the topic of X in your neighbourhood? (bipole question)




- 5. Which elements of X do you find most important about X? Please place them in the right order for you, ranging from most important at the top to least important at the bottom. (ranking question)


8. This advice is mainly about... Place a dot inside the triangle at the point that corresponds best with your answer. (tripole question)
