	be as detailed as possible in describing what happened. (open question)




## **INTERPRETATION QUESTIONS**

- 5. In what time scale do you consider this experience to start happening more frequently? *(bipole question)*




6. If your story would be published in a newspaper, what would be the headline? (open question)
